



Cookies information

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by the websites you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. The use of cookies is now standard for most websites. If you are uncomfortable with the use of cookies, you can manage and control them through your browser, including removing cookies by deleting them from your 'browser history' (cache) when you leave the site.

Types of cookie

'Session' cookies remain in your browser during your browser session only, ie until you leave the website.

'Persistent' cookies remain in your browser after the session (unless deleted by you).
